Bulk Item Pickup

Town of Superior residents participating in the town collection program can contact Republic Services to schedule a bulk item for removal.

The bulk item must be scheduled and paid for prior to collection. The bulk item will be scheduled for removal, not necessarily on your normal collection day. A Republic Services customer service representative will instruct you on what day to have your item out for collection. Fees do apply.

Service Days

Starting March 31, 2025, the Town of Superior’s waste services will begin with Republic Services.

The collection will be on Mondays between the hours of 7a.m. to 7p.m.

Recycling and trash will be serviced weekly. Organics/compost will be serviced every other week. Only cart content will be accepted.

Republic Services will be mailing out calendars to participating residents showing your specific collection day and compost collection week. Republic Services observes the following holidays: Christmas, New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and Thanksgiving.

If your service day falls on or after an observed holiday, you will experience a one-day delay. Weekend holidays will not cause a delay in service.

2025 Recycling, Trash and Compost Service Guide

ACTION NEEDED



Dear Town of Superior Residents,

Republic Services and the Town of Superior have partnered to work towards zero waste by providing residents with a three cart program for recycling, trash and compost service.

The price you pay corresponds with the size of your trash cart. Any size recycling cart and compost cart are included in the cost. You can select a different cart size for each if you wish. Below are the size and options for each cart.

Recycling: 35-gallon, 65-gallon and 95-gallon carts are available for weekly service at no additional cost.

Compost: 35-gallon, 65-gallon and 95-gallon are available for every other week service at no additional cost.

Trash: 35-gallon, 65-gallon and 95-gallon carts are available for weekly service. Refer to the chart below for costs by cart size.

ACTION NEEDED: Pick your cart sizes by 2/15

Before February 15, 2025, please call Nicole at **720.760.0849** or email **NMontoya@RepublicServices.com** to place your cart size selection order.

If you have not made your cart selection by February 15, 2025, the following carts will be delivered upon distribution: 95-gallon recycling, 35-gallon compost/organics and 65-gallon trash.

No cart changes will be allowed until May 1, 2025, to allow each resident to receive carts and service to begin on March 31, 2025.

Additional Cart Monthly Rates

Residents must have a 95-gallon cart of that waste stream to request an additional cart. The cost is \$7 per month for each additional recycling, compost or trash cart.

How to Prepare Your Items Properly for Collection

Trash

- Place your carts out at the curb or in the alley no later than 7 a.m. Drivers will begin their collections promptly at 7 a.m.
- Place carts at least 3 feet apart and with 5 feet of space between any other objects at the curb.

Recycling

- All recyclables should be empty, clean and dry.
- Do not bag your recyclables. Leave them loose in the cart.
- Recycle plastic bags at your local grocery store, or reuse them in your home.
- Make sure all recyclables are inside the cart with the lid closed to limit wind-blown debris.

Compost

- Please leave items loose in the cart. Grass clippings, leaves, small tree branches, plant trimmings, coffee grounds, meats/cheese, eggshells, fruit and vegetable peelings are accepted.
- Bags larger than 3-gallon compostable bags aren't allowed.
- Do not put weeds that have been sprayed with pesticides in your compost cart.

Recycling Electronics and Appliances

- Electronics and appliances cannot be recycled in your curbside cart. However, recycling options do exist through the options below:

 - ◇ Electronics recycling is available at select retailers, such as Best Buy or Staples. Restrictions and fees may apply.
 - ◇ Contact Xcel Energy (**xcelenergy.com**) for working refrigerator or freezer recycling.

Rates are volume-based and depend on which size trash cart you select. Any size recycling and compost cart is included in the cost.
