

Town Council Goals



Infrastructure

- Complete Rock Creek Parkway improvements, including a new roundabout at Coal Creek Drive
- Complete Indiana Street improvements from North Torreys Peak Drive to McCaslin Blvd
- Start construction on the North Pool improvements
- Complete design of the South Pool improvements and start construction
- Complete installation of the new Community Park playground improvements

Economic Development

- Construction of Alta Flatirons development – Block 8 – Downtown Superior
- Kite Route Crossing development start construction - Downtown Superior
- Continue to pursue commercial leases for Main Street
- Start construction of Bigsby Folly Craft Winery & Restaurant - Downtown Superior
- Approve Final Development Plan (FDP) of Food Hall (Block 7) and start construction - Downtown Superior
- Break ground on Blocks 2 & 5 - Downtown Superior
- Sundance Festival – continue to engage and participate in planning activities
- Focus on all commercial centers in town

Rocky Mountain Metropolitan Airport (RMMA)

- Continue to represent community interests
- Continue working through litigation, regional partnerships, and policy advocacy to pursue meaningful noise and safety relief

Marshall Fire recovery and resiliency

- Continue prioritizing and supporting residents in their rebuilding efforts
- Finalize plans for the Marshall Fire Remembrance Project and begin fundraising

Staffing

- Manage expectations of staff and provide support for projects, events, and services
- Continued follow-up on employee survey and implement recommended actions

Zip Code

- Continue to participate in, and support, the Zip Code Coalition in efforts to obtain the Town's own zip code

Housing

- Continue to explore opportunities for senior housing in town
- Promote Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) development and re-development
- Continue to explore opportunities for affordable housing in town

Community

- Cultural/Community Inclusion – explore forming an advisory committee or working group of residents
- Add events for community members that are under represented
