THREE CART PROGRAM

The Town has a “Three Cart Program,” where all residents on the Town’s contract have access to three carts: 1) Garbage 2) Recycling and 3) Compost and the cost customers pay is based on their selected garbage cart size. Waste hauling service for Original Town, Sagamore, The Ridge, Coal Creek Crossing, Downtown Superior, Calmante, Lanterns, Autrey Shores and Rogers Farm is contracted by the Town. The Town **does not** currently provide service to Rock Creek HOA residents, other HOAs on the Rock Creek waste contract like Saddlebrooke or the Summit or residents in apartment complexes.

Timeline	New service started with Republic Services on March 31.
What’s Included	Service includes weekly garbage and weekly recycling collection, with every other week compost collection. Residents will pick the cart size for each stream that work best for their household; you can pick different sizes for each if you wish. All waste will be picked up with electric collection trucks.
How Pricing Works	The Town is moving from a flat fee to a volume-based model where what you pay for service depends on which garbage cart size you select for your household; any size recycling cart and compost cart are included in the cost. You can swap cart sizes for free three times per year after May 1 to find the best service level for your household.

Service Reminders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Place your carts at the curb by 7 a.m. on Mondays ● Place your garbage in bags, recycling and yard waste can be loose ● Set wheels against the curb ● Keep carts 3 feet apart, and 8 feet from any obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, lamp posts, or power lines ● Break down and bundle all cardboard boxes no larger than 3' x 3' x 3' ● Please call Republic ahead for large items
